

Darrell is a graduate of the University of Manitoba (B.A.) and the University of Saskatchewan (B.Mus. Mus.Ed. and M.Ed. in instrumental music). He has performed with many professional organizations including both the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra and the Saskatoon Symphony Orchestra where he is now Principal Timpanist. In this role he has played for internationally known conductors and performers, Broadway musicals and touring ballets, as well as local choirs and theatre groups. His performances with other ensembles have taken him to Europe, the USA, and many parts of Canada including a series of performances in Inuvik and Aklavik, North West Territories.

In 2000 Darrell established Seashell Sound Productions in Saskatoon, specializing in producing quality acoustic recordings. Darrell's performances, compositions and arrangements have been recorded by CBC radio and featured on CBC radio Saskatchewan.

In addition to running a private teaching studio, Darrell is on faculty with the Department of Music at the University of Saskatchewan as an Applied Percussion Instructor and Sessional Lecturer in Music Education.
